Wascana Centre is offering a unique opportunity for two randomly selected schools to have one Grade 3 and one Grade 4 class participate in our *Sprouts* program. Selected schools will be given all the materials they need to grow native grass, flowers, and trees in their very own classroom.

Our knowledgeable staff will visit your school and give your classes all the information you need to have a successful growing season. Throughout the entire process, our team will be here for regular growth updates, troubleshooting, and encouragement.

After a successful growing period, students will be invited to Wascana Centre for a tour of our bustling greenhouse and nursery. They will even be given the opportunity to plant their grasses and wildflowers in the greenhouse where they will eventually find their way to our public gardens.

Wascana Centre wants to encourage students to be stewards of the land, to connect with their surroundings, and develop a lifelong appreciation of nature. This entire program is free for classes to participate. We will even cover the cost of your bus.

Wascana Centre will be accepting applications from interested schools until end of day March 13th. After that date two schools will be chosen at random for their Grade 3 and 4 classes to participate in our *Sprouts* program. Accepted classes will be notified by March 18th and will have to confirm participation before the deadline.
